- 1. Represents WTM Common Shares held under the Folksamerica 401(k) Plan. The information contained in this report is based on a plan statement dated as of February 26, 2004.
- 2. Phantom Shares are convertible into Common Shares on a 1 for 1 basis.
- 3. The Phantom Shares are payable, at the election of the Company, in cash or in Common Shares, following termination of the Reporting Person's employment with the Company or beginning at an earlier date selected by the Reporting Person.
- 4. The acquistion of phantom shares by the Reporting Person was made pursuant to a deferral agreement entered into during 2003.
- 5. The Phantom Shares are payable in cash following termination of the Reporting Person's employment with the Company.
- 6. On February 28, 2000, the Reporting Person was granted options to purchase WTM Common Shares on a 1 for 1 basis at an initial exercise price of \$106.19. The exercise price increases by 6% annually on a cumulative basis.
- 7. Reporting Person was originally granted 9,000 options to purchase Common Shares on February 28, 2000. 900 Options become exercisable annually over a ten-year period.
